WHAT SUPPORT DO WE PROVIDE?



The safety of women and children underpins the FAICM program. Supports are provided for the women and children impacted by the domestic violence, through a Women and Children's Advocate (WCA).

Participants are required to engage with a FAICM case worker in response to addressing their use of violent behaviours, with the aim to set, and achieve goals, through identified case plans.

FAICM works in partnership with our accredited Men's Behaviour Change program (Engage2Change). The focus is to support men to engage in the program for up to 16 weeks.

The program provides case management to men who have used domestic violence in their past or present relationships, and those who may be at risk of incarceration, or those upon release from goal.

Fixed Address Intensive Case Management (FAICM) is a way to engage men who have used domestic violence in a respectful, targeted program, to reduce risks to women and children.



WHAT IS FAICM?

Fixed Address Intensive Case Management (FAICM) is a program for men who have used domestic violence in past or current relationships. Participants are at risk of incarceration due to re-offending behaviours or are being exited from goal.

Through long term, intensive case management, case goals are set and support provided for men to achieve their goals. FAICM works in partnership with our accredited Men's Behaviour Change program (Engage2Change) to support men to commence their journey of non-violence.

The Fixed Address Intensive Case Management program is funded by the NSW Department of Communities & Justice.
